Other Photo ID as backup (such as Driver's license, or ASB card)			
Sleeping bag, blanket, and pillow			
Sleeping mat or cot			
Bible, paper, and pen/pencil			
Toiletries (such as toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, soap, shampoo, etc.)			
Towel and wash cloth			
Flashlight (bring extra batteries)			
Water bottle (Nalgene style) label with your name			
Folding - camp site chair (label with your name)			
Sunglasses and hat/visor			
Sunscreen			
Lip balm			
Personal hygiene wipes (optional)			
Insect repellent			
Work gloves			
Work boots - for muddy weather (optional)			
Comfortable closed toe shoes - (i.e. tennis shoes)			
Clothes for 8 days (See IMPORTANT clothing guidelines on reverse side)*			
Bathing suit and cover up (Girls - NO bikinis, 1-piece suit only)			
Rubber flip-flops			
Warm Jacket			
Sweatshirts			
Rain gear (such as poncho or rain suit)			
Personal medication			
1 roll toilet paper			
1 bottle instant hand sanitizer			
Money for 3 meals on the way to Mexico, and 4 meals on the way home			
Money for public showers in town (\$2 - \$5 per shower) (optional)			
Ear plugs (optional)			
Spending money (optional)

- Hair dryers/curling irons, any electronics
- Drugs, Alcohol, Cigarettes, Knives, Guns, Lighters
- Anything that would make the youth pastor uncomfortable

CLOTHING GUIDELINES FOR MEXICALI

Typical dress in Mexico is very conservative. In an attempt to love the Mexican people, there is a modest dress code we will follow. Please refer to these dress codes as you pack:

DAILY DRESS CODE:

Guy's Dress Code:

- * Keep shirts on in public at all times, even while doing work projects.
- * No shorts in public, including camp
- * Wear jeans without holes, and don't show your underwear
- * Wear khaki pants without holes, and don't show your underwear
- * No plain white T-shirts, beer T-shirts, tank tops, etc.
- * Take out body piercings, if possible
- * No sandals

Girl's Dress Code:

- * Shoulders, midriffs and thighs must be covered in public, including at camp.
(A good test is this: if you raise your hands above your head and anyone can see your midriff (tummy), don't wear that shirt.)
- * No shorts, no capri's in public, including camp
- * Wear jeans without holes, and don't show your underwear
- * Wear khaki pants without holes, and don't show your underwear
- * skirts/dresses which are below the knee
- * No plain white T-shirt, inappropriate T-shirts, tank tops, spaghetti straps, etc.
- * Wear clothes with a **modest** neckline
- * Wear light makeup, if any
- * Don't show body piercings
- * No sandals

Please keep in mind that evenings are very cold.
